Spanish - Beginner 2

Prerequisite and description

This is a basic level of Spanish, for those who know the alphabet, verb to be (ser), numbers from 0-20, notions of how to construct negative sentences. They should be capable to introduce themselves using a few sentences. The class is taught mainly in Spanish.

Besides of topics proposed in each level, an appealing approach for students introduce them not only to the linguistics of Spanish, but also culture, music, literature and artistic manifestations of Spain and Latin American Countries, highly attractive for the traveler or those interested in language and culture of Hispanic Countries.

Classes help develop the four skills: listening, writing, reading and speaking in a balanced manner. Learners will benefit from emphasising the Communicational approach (Spanish in real situations, for real purposes). Upon completion of this training, learners will receive a certificate as well as 2.5 units of Continuing Education Credits.

Objectives

At the end of level 2 students should be able to express their mood, be capable of ask and give directions in a basic way, be capable of command food at a restaurant and talk about their families.
