



Spanish - Beginner 1

Prerequisite and description

This level is for students who do not have any notion of Spanish or those who have had certain contact but would like to review the very basics. Besides of topics proposed in each level, an appealing approach for students introduce them not only to the linguistics of Spanish, but also culture, music, literature and artistic manifestations of Spain and Latin American Countries, highly attractive for the traveler or those interested in language and culture of Hispanic Countries.

Classes help develop the four skills: listening, writing, reading and speaking in a balanced manner. Learners will benefit from emphasising the Communicational approach (Spanish in real situations, for real purposes). Upon completion of this training, learners will receive a certificate as well as 2.5 units of Continuing Education Credits.

Objectives

At the end of the level 1 the students should be capable of introduce themselves in a simple way, and talk about their occupations and nationalities. They should be able of tell time and ask basic question for traveling purposes. Talk about future plans in a simple way.
